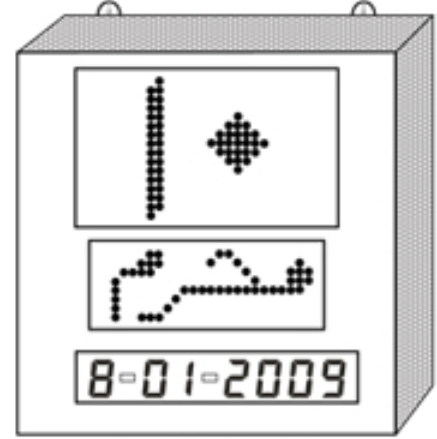


Date & Time Setting:

1. Press **1** to enter SET MODE. Hours Starts Blinking.
2. Use **2** and **1** to set HOURS as it starts Blinking.
3. Use **2** and **1** to set Minutes
4. Set one by one HOURS, MINUTES, AM (A),
PM (P), DATE, MONTH, YEAR.
5. Use **2** and **1** to set Day Light Saving. **DS=0** **DS=1**
 Note 1. DS = 0 → DST Disable
 DS = 1 → DST Enable
 2. Date is always set in Greogrian Mode.
6. Use **2** and **1** to set City Code.
7. Use **2** and **1** to select any one Language in
Urdu, Arabic or English.
8. Press **1** to Save and Exit from Set Mode



Remote Control

Adjust Moon Sight Difference:

1. Press **0** to enter ADJUST MODE.
2. Use **2** to adjust date.
3. Press **0** to Save and exit.

Features

Bright Digital Display of Hijri Date in languages like Arabic, Urdu and English. As the Islamic weekdays begins at sunset, Hijri date automatically changes at sunset (Maghrib).

Islamic Month, Year and Day of Week appear one by one on a single line. Special Islamic events like Eid, Shabe Qadar, Ashoorah announcement display at that day.

Easy adjustment of beginning of the month based on Moon sight. Complex mathematical calculations determine proper month changing.

Just set Time and Date (Gregorian) once, Islamic Date, Month and Year will be automatically calculated and displayed.

To Display special Day Messages:

1. Press **2** to view special Islamic announcements one by one.

(1 Shawwal : Eid Mubarak), (1 Muharram : New Year), (10 Muharram : Ashura), (10 Dhu al-Hijjah : Eid Mubarak), (15 Sha'ban : Shab-e-Barat), (27 Rajab : Shab-e-Miraj), (12 Rabi al Awal : Mawlid an Nabi / Yom-e-Wafat), (17 Ramadan : Yom-e-Badar), (21,23,25,27,29 Ramadan : Shab-e-Qadar)
